Dear Parents

Now that we have got back into the swing of things and our Summer Term is fully underway, I thought that I would just give you an update on a couple of issues.

The Summer Timetable, after some tweaking, now means that Years 5 and 6 have an extended Games lesson on a Monday and Years 3 and 4 have their extended Games lesson on a Tuesday. As a result of this the second Games lessons, which were on Wednesdays (Year 5 and 6) and Thursdays (Years 3 and 4) have been lost and we are able to provide more timetable provision for classroom curriculum subjects. I apologise for not giving prior notification of this, as I know that one or two of you have found it inconvenient.

Mrs Byers, a Cello Teacher, is joining us as a new member of the Peripatetic Music Team, with immediate effect.
