



SCHOOL BEHAVIOUR GUIDELINES

- **Children have the right to feel happy, safe and secure**
- **Children should look after and respect their own and other people's property and keep it tidy.**
- **Children should use non-offensive language in all situations.**
- **Fighting or upsetting other people is not allowed.**
- **Good manners are expected** (e.g. holding doors open for adults, standing in silence when a guest enters the room, not answering an adult back and not interrupting by calling out).
- **Children are expected to walk sensibly around the buildings, keeping to the left in corridors.**
- **Children should wait patiently by the gate and stay with the adult collecting them.**
- **Full school uniform should be correctly worn to and from school, and whilst in school or on school activities.**
