Key Highlights

- Nearly half of all awards 36% were Academic Scholarships, demonstrating strong academic preparation across the cohort.
- Creative and performing arts scholarships (Music, Art, Drama, Performing Arts) accounted for 39% of all awards, highlighting the strength of the school's creative curriculum.
- Sport scholarships represented 14% of awards, reflecting strong participation and achievement in sport.
- Pupils secured offers from some of the most competitive independent schools, grammar and state in Surrey and beyond, as well as leading international schools.

Headline Outcome

A cohort of just 19 pupils secured 28 scholarships and awards across leading independent, international and high-performing state schools.
